

Retention in Program.*

1. The grading scale for all graduate level courses in occupational therapy graduate/professional curriculum is as follows:

Credit Courses:

A=90-100

B=80-89

C=70-79

D=60-69

F=50-59

Non-credit courses:

S= Satisfactory or P (Pass)

U= Unsatisfactory or F (Fail)

I= Incomplete

No grade below “C” will be accepted for graduate credit. However, grades on all courses carrying graduate credit will be used in determining the overall grade point average. A graduate student (4th and 5th years) must maintain a “B” average (3.0) in all course work included in the program of study outlined for the degree, with no more than six semester hours of “C” grades. Undergraduates (1st, 2nd and 3rd year students) must complete prerequisite courses with a grade of “C” or higher.
